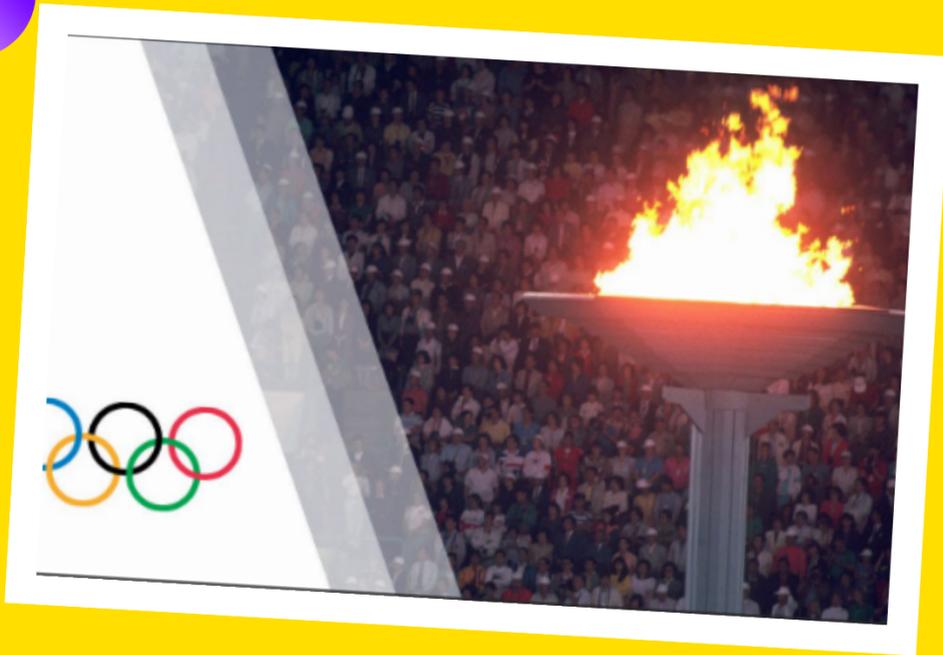

- Values: Perseverance, courage, confidence



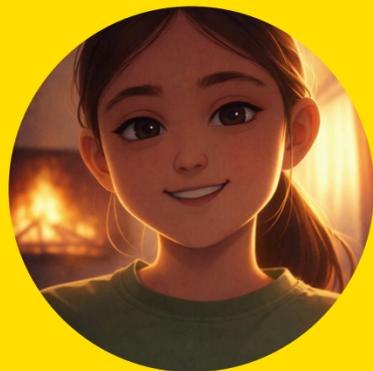
