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Key Objectives of the Collaborative Poster Activity

Unity in Diversity: It perfectly mirrors the EU motto. By combining different colors and styles from various partners into one single poster, it symbolizes how different cultures create a harmonious whole.

Collective Ownership: It fosters a sense of belonging. Students realize that the project is a shared responsibility and that the "big picture" is incomplete without their individual contribution.

Collaboration & Teamwork: The activity physically demonstrates that international cooperation is essential. It shows that every partner is an equal and vital piece of the project's identity.

Active Citizenship: By choosing and painting their own sections, students practice democratic participation, showing that every voice (and color) matters in building the European identity.

Visualizing Abstract Concepts: It turns complex EU values into a tangible result, making it easier for students to understand how local actions lead to international synergy.

European Green Deal / Video series

Comprehensive International Collaboration: This activity transforms the "European Green Deal" into a digital narrative series, enhancing both environmental awareness and digital production skills through global teamwork.

Environmental Literacy: By exploring topics like carbon neutrality and circular economy, students internalize critical EU goals and move from theory to active research.

Multimodal Communication: Recording voice-overs and designing visual-text combinations help 12-year-old students master digital storytelling and professional information presentation.

Synthesis & Research Skills: The challenge of summarizing complex EU policies into clear scripts and images helps students develop strong information processing and critical thinking skills.

Unified Digital Legacy: Dividing tasks among students from 6+ countries demonstrates high-level cooperation, resulting in a common video that serves as a professional-grade educational resource.

Environmental Sustainability / 2026 Calendar

Sustainability Integrated into Daily Life: The creation of an environmental sustainability calendar transforms macro-level EU goals (like the Green Deal) into tangible, micro-actions and awareness points that students can follow throughout the year.

Permanent & Scalable Dissemination: Making the calendar printable and the encyclopedia digital ensures that the project's message reaches beyond the classroom, serving as a lasting educational resource for the wider community.

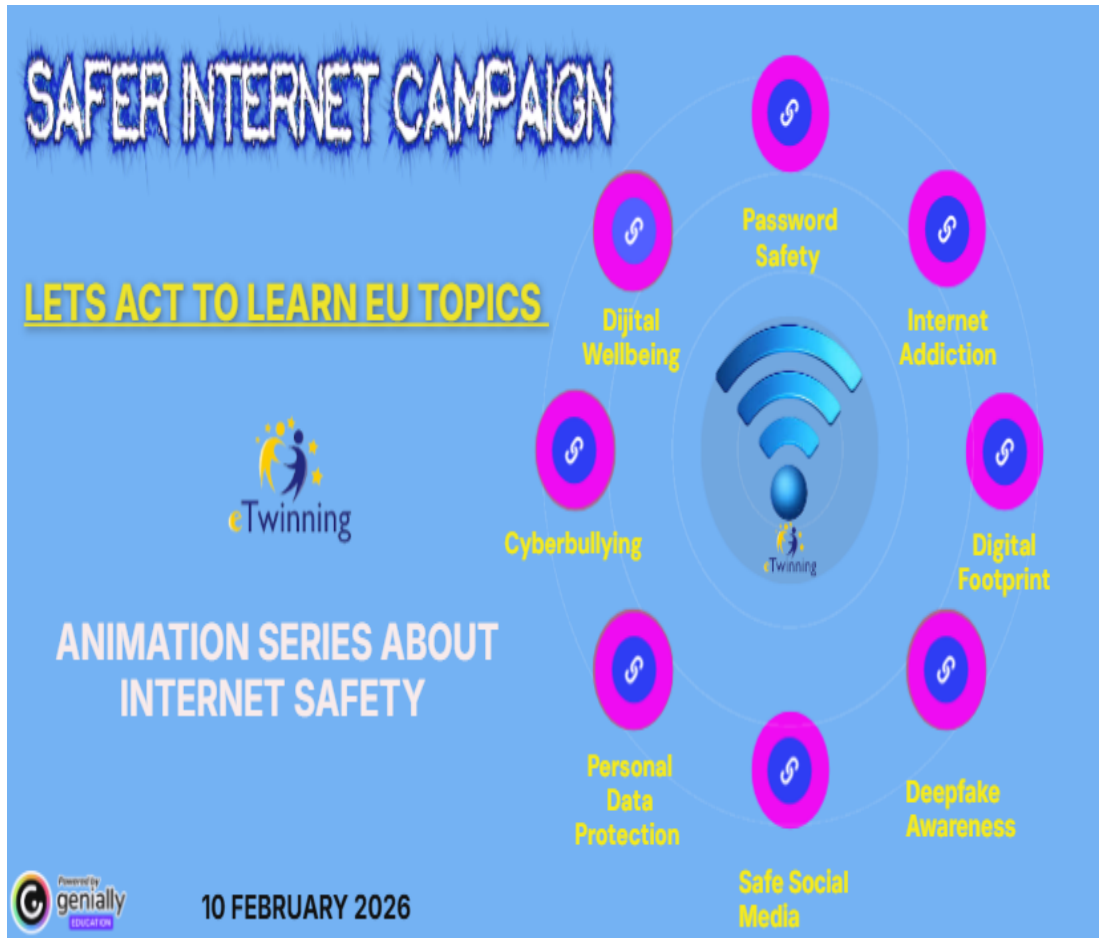

Key Objectives of the Internet Security Campaign Activity

Students as Creators: Learners evolved into digital content creators by using AI and animation tools to educate peers on internet safety.

Global Collaboration: Students from six countries (Spain, Türkiye, North Macedonia, Romania, Georgia, Croatia) co-produced a unified awareness campaign.

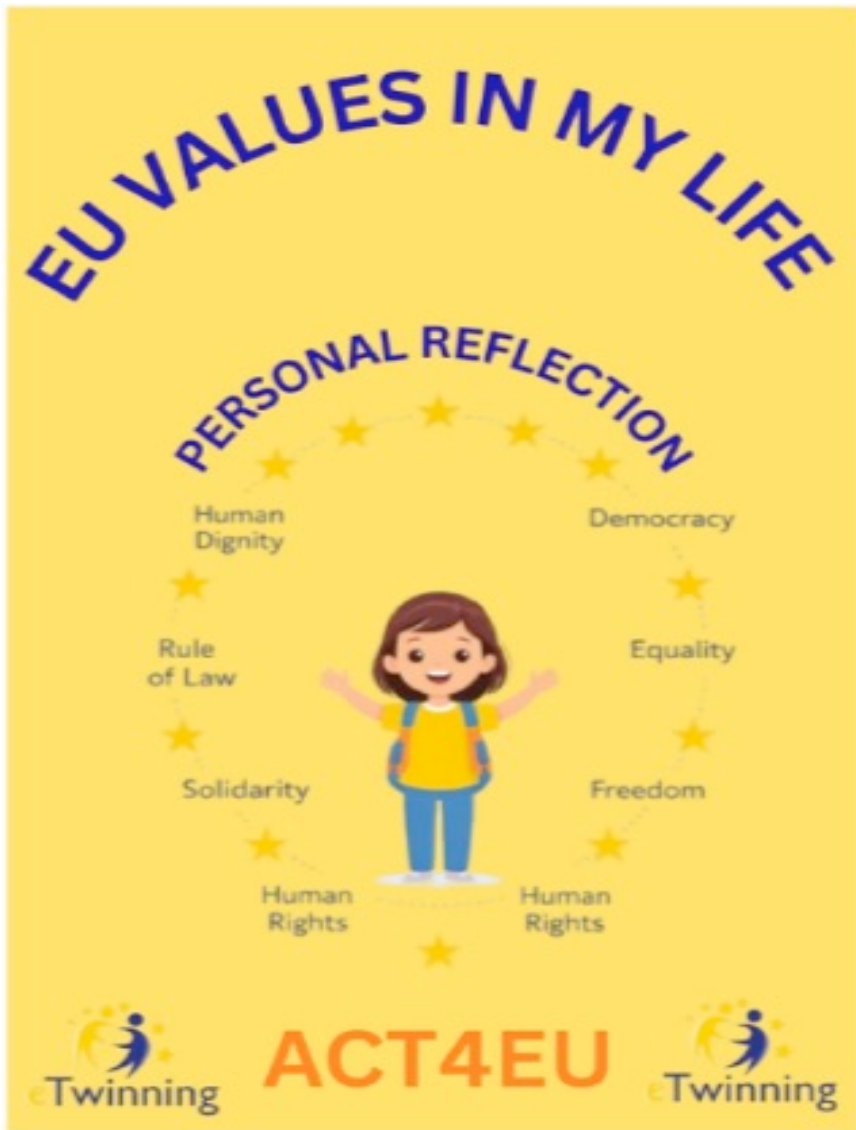
Advanced Digital Literacy: Complex topics like Deepfake awareness and Digital Footprints were transformed into engaging multimedia resources.

Maximum Impact: Launched on **Safer Internet Day**, ensuring a wide reach and a lasting educational legacy across the European community.

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EU Values Reflection: From Theory to Life

- Internalizing Values:** Students moved beyond memorization by connecting abstract EU concepts to their daily lives, schools, and communities.
- Critical Thinking:** By addressing deep questions like *"Why is this value important for humanity?"*, learners developed advanced information processing and academic writing skills.
- Active Citizenship:** Students actively embodied the **"Let's Act to Learn"** philosophy by identifying practical applications for justice, peace, and human rights.
- Lasting Impact:** Personal reflections were compiled into a public **online flipbook**, serving as a permanent educational resource to inspire the wider community.

Common E-Story: Nova and the Symphony of Values

Metaphorical Learning: EU values are taught through a musical metaphor, showing that peace requires different "notes" (values) to create a perfect harmony.

Inclusive Character: The protagonist, **Nova**, is a universal "being of light" without nationality or gender, ensuring every student can relate to the journey.

Collaborative Creativity: Seven international schools act as "Guardians" of a specific note and value, co-writing chapters and recording melodies.

International Synergy: Partners from **Romania, Georgia, Spain, Türkiye, Croatia, Italy, and Ukraine** unite their unique contributions into a single digital e-Book.

The Grand Finale: The story culminates in "Solidarity," where all individual notes merge to play the "**Ode to Joy**," symbolizing European unity.

Active Citizenship: Students don't just learn about values; they practice them through collective digital storytelling and artistic cooperation.
