I. RIGHT TO LIFE AND FAMILY


YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO LIVE, BE LOVED, CARED FOR, AND BE PART OF A FAMILY.


2. RIGHT TO PLAY AND LEISURE




3. RIGHT TO EDUCATION
